### CPD COMPLIANCE

Continuous Professional Development (CPD) compliance can often cause a lot of distress, especially if one realises too late that your CFE credential is at risk. Many CFEs face challenges in acquiring the required CPD during their reporting periods. To maintain your CFE Credential, you are required to accumulate at least 20 hours of CPD in a 12-month period. At least 10 of these hours must relate directly to the detection and deterrence of fraud and two hours must relate directly to ethics. If you have earned more than 20 hours of CPD in your previous reporting period, you may roll over up to 10 of these hours to meet your current CPD requirements. CPD earned prior to earning your CFE credential are not eligible for roll over. This includes any CPD earned from the CFE Exam Prep Course or the live CFE Exam Review Course.
